THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

BILL 418.

An Act for granting Her Majesty certain sums of money for the public service of the financial year ending the 31st March, 1958.

Most Gracious Sovereign,

Preamble.

WHEREAS it appears by messages from His Excellency, the Right Honourable Vincent Massey, etc., etc., Governor General of Canada, and the estimates accompanying the said messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the public service of Canada, not otherwise provided for, for the financial year ending the 31st day of March, 1958, and for other purposes connected with the public service: May it therefore please your Majesty, that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and 10 with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, that:

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act No. 4, 1957.

\$1,651.674,050 granted for 1957-58. 2. From and out of the Consolidated Revenue Fund, 15 there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole one billion, six hundred and fifty-one million, six hundred and seventy-four thousand and fifty dollars, towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the public service, from the 1st day of April, 1957, to the 31st 20 day of March, 1958, not otherwise provided for, and being one-half of the total of the amounts of the items set forth in the Main Estimates for the fiscal year ending the 31st day of March, 1958, as laid before the House of Commons at the present session of Parliament.
