

Railway Arrangements

GRAND TRUNK RAILWAY

From Detroit, Port Huron, and all points in Canada west of Prescott, on the Grand Trunk Railway System, single fare for the round trip any day between the 27th of August and the 6th of September, inclusive.

From all points in Canada east of Prescott, single fare for the round trip from Aug. 31st to Sept. 6th, inclusive.

From Buffalo and Niagara Falls, single fare, round trip, Aug. 27th to Sept. 6th, inclusive.

G.T.R. Special Cheap Excursion Days

August 29th—From St. Thomas, London, Lucan, Goderich, Kincardine, Southampton, Wainfleet, Owen Sound, Durham, Mono, Penetanguishene, Midland, Bracebridge, Bellville, Niagara Falls, Ont., Fort Erie, and all intermediate stations, including Midland Division and L.H. & B. branch.

Aug. 31st and Sept. 2nd—From stations in Canada east of but not including Prescott.

Sept. 2nd and 3rd—From Berlin and Waterloo.

Sept. 2nd and 4th—From all stations Prescott to Detroit and Port Huron, inclusive, and all lines and branches south thereof in Canada; Midland Division; N. & N.W. Division, Gowan, Micaesing and north; also stations Terra Cotta to Caldon East, inclusive; Elora to Moorefield, inclusive; and Sebringville to Goderich, inclusive.

September 3rd and 5th—From all stations on branch lines north of Moorefield, Stratford and Lucan Crossing (excepting Sebringville to Goderich), also Brampton; N. & N.W. Division, Palgrave to Mcasford and Barrie; Colwell to Stayner; Davenport to Craigvale; also Ingleswood and Cheltenham.

All tickets good for return up to Sept. 6th.
