

Massachusetts Bay, and that entitled, "An Act for the better Administration of Justice, &c." Also, the Act for regulating the Government of Quebec, and the Act, passed in the same Session, relating to the Quarters of Soldiers, shall be, and are Hereby suspended, and not to have Effect or Execution, from the Date of this Act. - And be it moreover Hereby declared and enacted, by the Authority aforesaid, that All and Every the before-recited Acts, or, the Parts thereof complained of, shall be, and are, in Virtue of this present Act, finally Repealed and Annulled, from the Day that the due Recognition of the Supreme Legislative Authority and Superintending Power of Parliament over the Colonies, shall have been made on the Part of the said Colonies.

And for the better securing Due and Impartial Administration of Justice in the Colonies, be it declared and enacted, by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons in this present Parliament assembled, that His Majesty's
