CHANGED FUTURES HIGHER

Despite Big Visible Increase and Large Receipts.

Steady Cables, Heavy Clearances, Good Cash Demand and Fair Takings at Seaboard Were Bullish Factors—A Budget of Interesting Items on the Price Outlook—Stocks in Store.

Monday Evening, Oct. 17. Liverpool this morning reported stocks of red winter wheat exhausted. Futures closed unchanged to 3/4 cent lower than on Saturday.

World's Wheat Yield.

Estimates by the commercial authorities of England on the world's wheat yield for 1898 have been made as follows:
