

AYRE & SONS, Fancy Goods, St. John's, Newfoundland

THORBURN LAKE, a station on the railway, 82 miles from Placentia Junction, 146 miles from St. John's, fares \$4.65 and \$3.25.

THREE ARMS (Western, Southern and Middle) of Green Bay, post, fishing and farming settlements in Twillingate district; nearest money order, telegraph, port of entry, coastal steamer at Little Bay; railway station Norris Arm, connected by bay steamer; population 100.

THREE ISLAND HARBOR, in Bonavista district; all connections at or the same as Green's Pond.

TIBBOS, a small settlement in Bay des Vieux, Burgeo and LaPoile. *See Bay des Vieux.*

TICKLE COVE, a post, fishing and lumbering settlement in Bonavista district; nearest railway station Clode Sound; all other connections at or the same as Kings Cove, 10 miles; connected by courier; contains 1 church; population 250.

TICKLE HARBOR (or Bellevue), a post fishing and farming settlement in Trinity district; nearest money order New Harbor; telegraph and railway Tickle Harbor Station; port of entry and coastal steamer Placentia; population 150.

TICKLE HARBOR STATION, a railway station in the District of Trinity, 25 miles from Whitbourne — 82 miles from St. John's; fares \$2.75 and \$2.05.

TILT COVE (Green Bay), a post, money order, telegraph, port of entry and copper mining settlement, in District of Twillingate; nearest railway station Norris' Arm, 50 miles, by water, connected weekly by bay steamer; coastal mail steamer from St. John's fortnightly, during summer, 317 miles, fares \$8.00 and \$4.00; winter mails weekly by rail and courier; a large copper mine is situated here which has been working for many years, in fact it is the oldest in the Island; annual output 70,000 tons copper ore; contains 6 stores, 3 churches and schools; good harbor though rather open to the sea; population 1,400.

TILTON, an inland post, telegraph, railway station and farming settlement in Harbor Grace district; money order and all other connections at or the same as Harbor Grace, 5 miles; contains 3 stores, 1 hotel, 2 churches, a good sporting locality; a jam factory ought to flourish here, wild berries of all kinds being in abundance; population 400.
