Rev. John Lawrence.

Whereas, Rev. John Lawrence travelled the Gaspe Mission under the direction of the Chairman from 1874 to 1875, and having, in view of the year being allowed him, paid his subcription to the Superannuated Minister's Fund, and whereas his name stands on the Minutes of Conference indicating his reception in 1875. Resolved, that this Conference allow him the additional year.

Ordination Sermon.

Resolved,—That hereafter the Ordination Sermon in each year be preached by the President of the previous year.

Laymen on Contingent Fund, Ottawa Conference, 1877.

Resolved,—That the seven laymen who are to constitute that portion of the Contingent Fund Committee, shall be chosen from the Districts contiguous to the seat of the next Conference, as follows: Ottawa, 3; Brockville, 2; Perth, 1; Pembroke, 1.
