\$30,000,000 Credit Under Discussion

Proposal That Banks Finance British Purchase of Canadian Grain-Three-Cornered Plan

A proposal has been made to the Canadian banks to finance purchases of grain in Canada for the Imperial government to the extent of \$30,000,000 but The Gazette understands that the matter has not yet gone beyond the discussion stage and may not go any further. A definite decision regarding the proposal now before the banks will probably be reached in the course of the next few days.

To the extent that the arrangement would represent a further measure of assistance from the Canadian banks to the Imperial authorities in the latters' financing of supplies bought in Canada, it is along similar lines to previous credits granted in the past year or so.

In a banking way, however, it would differ materially. For the previous credits granted, the banks have received British exchequer securities, investing in them out of their funds to the extent of the different amounts advanced. The new credit arrangement would be rather on commercial lines; in effect, it would be a three-cornered transaction between the hanks, the grain purchasing agents

be a three-cornered lines; in effect, it would be a three-cornered transaction between the banks, the grain purchasing agents of the Imperial government, and the Imperial government itself, the banks financing the government's undertaking.

There are certain difficulties in the way and it is open to question whether the arrangement will go through, at least in the form in which it is now under discussion.

With the \$50,000,000 credit granted in September last, the total credits from the Canadian chartered banks to the Imperial authorities rose to \$200,000,000.

That a further arrangement of the sort, even if on different lines, should be under consideration at so should be under consideration at so should an interder consideration at so short an interval is an interesting indication of the part that the banks are being asked to play in war financing.


