WINS HIGH HONORS.

(Frederick Gleason.) Another graduate of the University of New Brunswick and a Rhodes scholar, has won high honors at Oxford, England, according to word received here today and is not only an honor for the recipient, Murray McC. Baird, but for his alma mater, U. N. B. as well.

Mr. Baird, who is a son of Mr. and Mrs. H. P. Baird, formerly of this city, but who recently removed to the Pacific coast to reside, has just received a first class in physiology at Oxford University. This has only been attained by one other Rhodes scholar, J. B. McNair, who received first class in jurisprudence. Mr. Baird graduated from U. N. B. in 1916 with the degree of B. A., and was Rhodes Scholar for that year. He was at New College, Oxford, played in the football team, won one of the crews in 1920, was president of the Oxford Colonial Club in 1921, and maintenance representative of students at Oxford. He plans on spending two years at St. Bartholomew's Hospital, London, in the study of medicine.
