MR. SEIDENSTICKER

NOW A DIRECTOR OF ATLANTIC REFINERIES

F. G. O'Grady Also Given Place on Board-Dividend Declared-Monthly Business About \$2,000,000

Montreal, Nov. 29.-Directors of Atlantic Refineries, Limited, following a meeting held here yesterday afternoon, declared a dividend of 13-4 per cent on the preferred stock for the current quarter and in addition a payment of 1-2-4 per cent on account of arrears, making 8 1/2 per cent in all, payable Jan. 2 next to shareholders of record Dec. 12. The company's business, aggregating \$2,000,000 monthly, has been highly satisfactory, but the condition of the raw sugar market was such as to render advisable the conservation of a strong cash position.

Following the meeting it was learned that Victor E. Mitchell, K. C., had retired from the board and that F. G. O'Grady, the general manager of the company here, together with L. J. Seidensticker, superintendent of the refinery at St. John, N. B., had been added to the directorate.
