Mr. Asquith continued: "I doubt whether any man in the world recognizes the full significance of the step America has taken. I do not use language of flattery or exaggeration. The step is one of the most disinterested acts in the history of more than one hundred years. It has been the cardinal principle of American policy to keep clear of foreign entanglements. To do this it has been necessary to dislocate international commerce and finance, but on the balance it was going little appreciated. It was a return to the material fortunes and prosperity of the American people."

John Dillon Welcomes U. S.

After former Premier Asquith had concluded his address John Dillon extended greetings to the United States in the name of the Irish Nationalists.

"The Nationalists join most heartily in the welcome to the United States," Mr. Dillon said. "The full meaning of the step the American people have taken in the struggle is difficult to describe. It is not like the entrance of the other allies, but has a more mighty significance to the whole civilized world. It was a breach with the tradition of a century, a tradition adhered to with vehemence and passion of the principle laid down by Washington, that the country keep clear of entangling alliances."


"President Wilson's speeches to congress are documents that will go down in history among the noblest of the civilization of the world's statesmen. The difficulties of the American people have been confronted in the last two and one half years have not been sufficiently appreciated in this country. I had to keep the nation united and I tried to deal with a people which had a deep seated and ineradicable hatred of war. To bring the United States into the war was to make them go against one of the cardinal principles of the American race. The statesmanship, courage and patience of President Wilson bring him into the forefront of all
