Thould have communicated to me any information in his possession which he considers to be more authentic than that obtained by exhaustive local inquiries, Jeeing that my only object is to obtain correct statements for your information. I shall be glad if he will make such a com munication now so that I may take much steps as may be necessary to improve and further secure our Census returne. To do this Mr Lenihan must state particulars as follows. State the name of the person with " who took the census compagned " the date and place of taking it,
