10, 1958, at Ottawa. Upon completion of training at "N" Division, Schryer was posted to "C" Division, Quebec, serving at Bedford and Montréal. He was subsequently transferred to the following locations: February 18, 1965, to Headquarters, namely to Visa Control duties overseas, in Paris and Brussels; July 4, 1972, to Headquarters; March 8, 1976, to "C" Division, at Montréal, retiring to pension April 2, 1993. Schryer was promoted to corporal May 1, 1968; sergeant July 1, 1973; inspector February 1, 1976, and superintendent May 29, 1986.
