

D. he would see wares of various kinds brought and sold, the sacred hours given up to sinful pleasure, railway trains in op-ration, and—perhaps most dreadful of all—members of churedes using their vehicles to minister, for fithy lucre, to the illicit desire of the soldiers for pleasurediving.
