

a just compensation, such account or claim shall not be included in the report so to be made to His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, and such person shall be absolutely excluded from any compensation or share of the charitable funds before mentioned.

V. *And be it further enacted,* That if any person or persons shall be guilty of false swearing in any examination made by the said Commissioners respectively under and by virtue of this Act such person or persons so offending shall upon conviction thereof before the Supreme Court or any Court of Oyer and Terminer or Gaol Delivery, be liable to suffer the pains and penalties by Law imposed for wilful and corrupt perjury.

VI. *And be it further enacted,* That it shall and may be lawful for the Lieutenant-Governor to appoint a suitable person to be Secretary to the said Commissioners, and also in case of a vacancy or vacancies by death or
