Chief loss on spirits and tobacco.
3. The total decrease on the whole of the revenues included in the above Statement, is more than accounted for by the decrease in the duties collected on spirits and tobacco. The decrease on the former being $\$ 449,041$, and in the latter $\$ 145,060$, or $\$ 594,101$ on these two articles. The decrease in the revenue derived from petroleum is accounted for by the repeal of the duty which took effect on and from the 20th February, 1877. The collection, therefore, extended only over a period of seven and a half months.
