

**B I L L .**

An Act to form a new Township out of parts of the Townships of Cramahé and Murray in the County of Northumberland.

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to form a New Township Preamble.  
out of portions of the townships of Cramahé and Murray, in the County of Northumberland, in accordance with the petition of the great majority of the inhabitants of the tract to be comprised within the said New Township: Be it therefore enacted, &c.,

I. That there shall be in the said County of Northumberland a New Township, to be called the Township of Brighton, which shall include and consist of all the lots Of what the new Township shall consist.  
10 from number one to number ten, both inclusive, in the first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth and tenth concessions, and in the broken front of the present Township of Cramahé, and of the lots from number twenty-three to number thirty-five, both inclusive, in the first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, eighth, ninth, tenth and eleventh concessions; and in the Commencement of Act.  
15 concessions A and B, and the broken front of the present township of Murray, and the peninsula of Presqu'isle.

II. And be it enacted, That this Act shall have effect on and after the first day of January, 1852, and not before, and this Act shall supercede any provision of the Act of this Session, intituled "*An Act to make certain alterations in the Territorial Divisions of Upper Canada,*" which may be inconsistent with this Act.
