respective Colonies or Provinces, unless and until the said Colonies or Provinces shall, by Bills or Acts of their respective Legislatures to which His Majesty's Consent shall in the usual Form be signified, unite and agree in directing any other Mode in which such Surplus shall be applied and disposed of.

III. And be it further enacted, That this Act may be altered, Act may be varied, or repealed by any Act or Acts to be passed in this present altered. Session of Parliament.
