I have the honor to enclose a copy of a letter from Mr. Indian Agent Lash applying for authority for the erection of a suitable frame house for Mr. Instructor McIntosh on Muscoupetungs Reserve. In view of the fact that there are no building logs on the Reserve and it being impossible to purchase any in the District, I am directed by the Commissioner to recommend that the sum of \$500⁰⁰ be authorized for the building of the house in question. Mr. McInnon can give a hand at the building and a similar house to that on Pea Pots Reserve can be erected for the above money.
