Sir,

Louis Tewasharasere has withdrawn one of his sons named Ignace, No. 11 from the Institution and intends to apply to your authority for the re-admission of his son Ch. Warrenahquah, who is about sixteen years of age to fill his place. The intention mentioned renders it proper that I should inform you that the conduct of Charles at the time of his departure from the Institution was uncontrollable by my authority and that it is probable if he be readmitted after the long indulgence & liberty of home, he will disturb the order of the school & be an evil example for the imitation of the younger scholars. I am persuaded by his aversion to industry & study that his object is only the avoidance of his labour at home. I beg permission to mention for the consideration of your
