It might interest you to know that last year we carried 10,000 men in and out of the mines. During the first 10 months of this year we have already carried 10,000 men in and out of the mines.

I do not want to bore you with too much detail but I felt that some time I would like you to know a little more about the job we are doing and trying to do, because I feel that we are doing one of the best constructive jobs that is being done in the Dominion of Canada and have been a very great factor in the bringing in of new wealth.

In the meantime any good word you can put in for us with the Hydro Commission or anyone else looking for aerial photographic service or anything in the way of aerial transportation will be appreciated. I hope to see you when you are next in Winnipeg. With kind regards, I remain,
