



Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st instant, with which you submitted your travelling expense account from April to November; and in reply I have to inform you that in future you should render such accounts monthly. The fact that you receive an advance does not obviate the necessity for your rendering a monthly statement of expenditure. In future the Department will insist upon your sending in monthly accounts. Be good enough to send in at once ~~any~~ travelling expense accounts for the balance of the present fiscal year, viz: for the months of December, January, February and March. Now that you have a clerk the Department considers that there should be no delay in the preparation and transmission of accounts. The accounts submitted are being examined and you will be further advised in regard to them.
