
With reference to your Return of Assignments for the month of October last, I have to return herewith for amendment, the Transfer from Norman McLean to Henry Alton, covering the S. 1/4 S.W. 1/4 Sec. 4, Kehoe, as the signature of the party before whom the Affidavit of Execution was taken, has been omitted.

In connection with the Assignment from the Heirs of the late James McLean to Edward McLean, covering the W. 1/4 N.W. 1/4 Sec. 30, Meredith, I have to state that before this document can be accepted by the Department, it will be necessary for you to furnish evidence as to the death of James McLean, that he died intestate, that all his heirs have joined in the Assignment, and that they are all of the full age of twenty one years.

It is noted that although eight Assignments were forwarded by you under cover of the October Return, only Fees for four of these documents were included in your Fee Return for the same month. In future, you will be good enough to state in the Remarks Column, opposite each Transfer, the date upon which the Fee for same was sent to the Department.
