Ottawa, June 14, 1915.

Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 8th instant

I beg to inford you that under the provisions of the

Indian act no Indian can participate in any Indian dance;

outside the bounds of his own reserve without the consent
of the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs or his
authorized Agent.

You should consult with your Agent Mr. Gordon who will explain to you fally the law in regard to Indian dances.
