

10. BADGES, CHEVRONS AND ARMLETS (CON'T)

after para 4 add:--

"5. Tradesmen's badges will be worn as follows:--

- (I) By Warrant Officers --  
On the right forearm immediately above the badge of rank or appointment.
- (II) By N.C.O.'s--  
On the right forearm with the lower edge  $6\frac{1}{2}$  inches from the bottom of the sleeve and above the service chevrons.
- (III) By Privates and equivalent--  
On the right upper arm at a point midway between the shoulder seam and the elbow."
