With reference to your letter of January 19th and Mr. C. E. Webb's suggestion that the pipe line in Chekwelp I. R. #26 be surveyed at the time when the proposed resurvey of the subdivided area in the Reserve is being made, I have discussed this matter with Mr. Indian Agent Ball who has shown on the attached plan the approximate location of the tees in the pipe line and the individual lots of the subdivision. The yellow circles represent the tees and the area outlined in red is the present road allowance. It would appear that the pipe line follows the travelled road from the north boundary of the Reserve as far as the south boundary of Lot 20 where it leaves the road allowance and continues in a southerly direction through Lots 19 and 18 and possibly further although the exact distance is unknown.

It is understood that Lots 12 and 13 do not obtain their water supply thmough this system and the location of the tees, if any, in Lots 14 to 17 is unknown.

It would be appreciated if you would let me have a further three or four copies of the attached print as our supply is now exhausted.
