SUBJECT: Accident - Piper J3C-65 Aircraft, CF-BUS, - 26th September, 1957, - Departmental Board of Inquiry.

MEMORANDUM TO THE DEPUTY MINISTER:

- 1. Piper J3C-65 aircraft, CF-BUS, owned by Messrs.
 E. J. Campbell and J. Osborne of Arcola, Saskatchewan, and under the command of Pilot E. J. Campbell crashed approximately one-half mile west of Arcola, Saskatchewan. The pilot and passenger were killed and the aircraft was destroyed.
- 2. Indications are that the aircraft spun from the top of a loop as a result of the pilot attempting to fly the aircraft while under the influence of alcohol.
- 3. It is recommended that a Departmental Board of Inquiry be constituted and a formal authority is therefore attached for approval and signature.
