Brand says, that "though its customs vary in different countries, yet they concur in the same end—that it is to do honor to the Eastern Magi." Some of the observances on this day, however, are the remains of Druidical and other superstitious ceremonies. Bourne, in his "Vulgar Antiquities," remarks that Twelfth Day is the greatest of the twelve holidays, and is therefore more jovially observed, by the visiting of friends and Christmas gambols, than any other.
