general Quarter Sessions, to be holden for the District, and shall lay before the Justices of such Sessions, the proper vouchers for the same, and the discharges of the faid Justices of the Peace, or the greater part of them, by their orders made at their general Quarter Sessions to such treasurers, shall be taken and allowed as good and sufficient acquittances to the full amount thereof.

XIV. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That it shall and may be lawful for the faid Justices of the Peace at their general Quarter Sesfions or the greater part of them from time to time, to continue fuch treasurer in his office so long as they shall see convenient, and to remove nim at their surer. pleasure and to appoint any other proper person in his place.
