in good repair, Be it therefore enacted by the King's most excellent Majefly, by and with the advice and confent of the Legislative Council and Astembly of the Province of Upper Canada, conflituted and affembled by virtue of, and under the authority of an A& passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, entitled " an Act to repeal certain parts of an Act paffed in the fourteenth year of his Majefty's reign, entitled "an Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the Province of Quebec in North America, and to make further provision for the Government of the faid Province," and by the authority of the fame, Be it enacted, that the King's high road which leads through the faid tract between the township of Malden and the township of Sandwich, be kept in good and fufficient repair by the inhabitants of the faid townships, that is to fay, the fouthern half of the faid road by each and every perfon living within and inhabiting the township of Malden, and the northern half of the faid road, by each and every perfon living within and inhabiting the townflip of Sandwich.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That the bridge which has been erected over the River aux Canards, shall be and is hereby directed to be kept in good and fufficient repair, by the inhabitants of the aforefaid townthips generally.

III. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That if any perfon as Penalty for reaforefaid shall refuse to work upon the faid road or towards the repair of the faid bridge, after he fhall have been warned fo to do, according to law; if fhall and may be lawful for any one Magistrate to iffue his warrant to bring fuch offender before him, and to inflict luch punishment as may now be inflicted upon any defaulter for neglect or refulal to work upon any other his Majefty's highways in this Province.

IV. And be it further enacted by the authority aforefaid, That the flatute labour herein directed is not to extend beyond the quota of flatute labour as now regulated by law, but is to be a part thereof.
