Military Service Bill Is Reported From Committee Of The Whole LAURIER ASKS DELAY Exemption Clauses Amended By Elimination Of Divinity Students QUEBEC'S PROTESTS Increased Premiums on Soldiers' Insurance Policies Discussed

Ottawa, July 20.—The Military Service Bill was reported from the Committee of the Whole in the Commons last night, and will be read a third time on Tuesday next. It had been expected that the final stage of the passage of the measure through the Chamber would be reached to-day.

When the House went into Committee of the Military Service Bill, Hon. Chas. Macleod said he had received letters from several business men in Montreal who expected to be called under the Act, and wanted to know if they would be allowed a month or two to wind up their business affairs before going into the service.

Hon. Mr. Meighen replied that provision had been made in the Act to grant such men opportunity to wind up business affairs before going into the service.

Michaelis' Speech Holdout, Bluff

Chancellor's Inaugural Address Criticized By The French Press

Paris, July 20.—Most newspapers reserve their judgment of Chancellor's Michaelis' maiden speech until the full text arrives, but all print prominently the summary and use verbatim such portions of the speech as were received up to the time of going to press. The Matin says the program of the Prussian militarism set forth by the chancellor may be summarized in the words "holdout and bluff," the most striking example of bluff being the disdain wherewith he affects to treat American intervention.

The Matin further points out that the occasion marked by innovation is likely to have great effect in the future—parliament considered it impossible merely to accept the government's declarations, and itself formulated its own views on peace and war.

The Figaro finds the difference between von Bethmann-Hollweg and Michaelis is that the former has for the past year been leaning more towards the left and making certain concessions to Conservatives so as to keep his seat among them.

An Exchange Telegraph despatch from Copenhagen says that Chancellor Michaelis, who arrived shortly before three o'clock, looked very grave as he entered the building in a hurry, cheered by the crowd. The chancellor was dressed in black frock coat. He held a consultation in an undertone with Dr. Karl Hellferich, the vice-chancellor.

Dr. Johannes Kaempf, president of the reichstag opened the session with a speech in which he extolled the services of Dr. von Bethmann-Hollweg, the former chancellor, which was read the order appointing the new chancellor. Dr. Michaelis then began his speech, which consisted of concise phrases in keeping with his energetic personality.
