



London, May 20. The Government has adopted the policy of the iron hand in dealing with sedition in Ireland. All the leaders of the Sinn Fein Society have been arrested by a swift, comprehensive dragnet drawn by the police and soldiers during the night and early hours of the morning. The movement was apparently a complete surprise, and most of those arrested were quickly and quietly placed aboard ships.


