**Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations.**

THE sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency) on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months residence upon cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter section alongside his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre.

Duties—Six months residence in each of three years after earning homestead patent; also 50 acres extra cultivation. Pre-emption patent may be obtained as soon as homestead patent, on certain conditions.

Settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months out of three years, cultivate 50 acres and erect a house worth \$300.

The area of cultivation is subject to reduction in case of rough, scrubby or stony land. Live stock may be substituted for cultivation under certain conditions.

**Helps For Housekeeping**

Dry your celery tops, leaves and small stems not used on the table for soups and seasoning all through the winter by putting them into a paper bag and hanging the bag up in a cool place. Parsley also may be saved this way.

You can have onion tops green all winter, ready for salads, soups, etc. by putting on onion into top (only touching the water it little) of a vase filled with water. An ordinary small top bottle may be used. Try it and watch it grow. Change the water every day. Then when the onion is gone put another in and so on all winter.
