## Liquor May Be Seized on I. C. R. Premises.

MINISTER OF RAILWAYS ISSUES ORDER.

As a result of representations made at the request of the Nova Scotia Temperance Alliance to the Minister of Railways, through Rev. Dr. Shearer, of the Moral and Social Reform Council of Canada, regarding the transportation of liquor on the I. C. R., the following order has been issued by the minister. It is dated January 25th and addressed to E. Tiffin, Esq., Government Railways Managing Board:

"Notify all agents and employees of the railway, giving direction that all officers of the law must be given access to any and all of the premises where freight is kept so that they may enter, inspect, search and seize liquor improperly shipped in contravention to any of the following laws: the Canadian Temperance Act, the New Brunswick and Nova Scotia Liquor License Acts, the Prince Edward Island Prohibition Act, and the Nova Scotia Temperance Act."

It must be very gratifying to temperance workers in the provinces that no request has been granted. Here liquor dealers have been established, by shipping liquor marked "groceries," "provisions," "glassware," and so forth, to evade the provisions of the law.

## No Camp Canteens.

The Minister of Militia, the Hon. Col. Hughes, deserves warm commendation for the strong stand he takes against drink in the militia camps. 
## Right Teaching.

The State of Iowa has shown that a common sense public school education can make children not only contented with farm life but anxious to follow that above any calling. The results of teaching agriculture and home economics in 31 schools in Wright county, show that before these subjects were taught, 157 boys wanted to leave the farm and only 7 were willing to stay, while 163 girls wanted to leave the farm and only 11 to stay. ## Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations.

A family of any male over 16 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made by any agency, on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.  
Duties—Six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres solely owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.  
In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section along side his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside upon the homestead of pre-emption six months in each of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and cultivate fifty acres extra.  
A homesteader who has exhausted his best and right, and cannot obtain a pre-emption may enter for a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate fifty acres and erect a house worth \$300.00.



## NADA EXPORTS ROSE FOR CATCH

Seven hundred and twenty five thousand dollars was the value of furs brought to Edmonton from the north country and trans-shipped in one week recently to London, Paris, New York, New Orleans, and Boston. The Hudson's Bay Co. head of the list, with 457,000 worth of furs, having shipped there last 126,000, the Northern Trading Company 100,000, and independent fur-traders make up the balance. The skins were of the highest quality and were in the best of condition. There were several silver fox skins, each valued at from \$1,000 to \$3,000, and others ranging in value from \$100 to \$1,000. The total weight of furs was larger than in former years. The other skins were marten, mink, beaver, fox, bear, deer of various kinds and muskrat. Most of the furs were from the country north and east of Slave Lake and the Mackenzie River, and from the Peace River district and the northern portion of the Provinces of Alberta and British Columbia.
