

CONSUME 9 POUNDS OF TEA PER HEAD YEARLY

The London Grocers' Gazette for Jan. 8, states that the consumption of tea in Great Britain and Ireland has increased 34 per cent since 1913. They now use about nine pounds per head per annum in the United Kingdom, and the increase in 1921 over the previous year amounted to pounds. This enormous 17,000,000 consumption accounts for the great rise in the price of tea.
