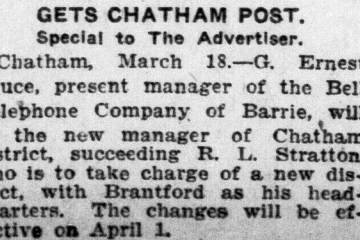


ST. MARYS CRICKETERS FORM.
