HE WILL ACCOMPANY MR. LAURIER ON HIS TOUR.
The Member for Etahat Will Make His First Speech in Kingston Oct. 11—He Denies Writing the Article Containing the Ontario Separate Schools—Notes From Montreal.
Montreal, Oct. 7.—The announcement that Mr. J. Israel Tarte has been invited to accompany Hon. Wilfrid Laurier on his tour of Ontario and to be the member for Etahat has been accepted with a good deal of surprise in the Liberal circles here when it is remembered that Mr. Tarte, who has not heretofore been known as a public speaker, has accepted the pleasure of accompanying his leader to the sister province.
"Mr. Tarte," so the notice reads, "member for Etahat, has been invited by the Liberal Party of Ontario to speak in English to the English in several of the counties to be visited by Hon. Mr. Laurier. Mr. Tarte has accepted with pleasure. He has accepted the invitation to accompany the Premier on October 11 in Kingston and on the 13th he will speak at Sydney, on the 15th at Markham, and on the 22nd at Galt.
