It is designed to provide Canadian graduate students with an opportunity to study abroad during a regular academic year of the receiving country.

Austria, Belgium, China, Colombia, Denmark, Federal Republic of Germany, Finland, France, Egypt, Greece, Hungary, Mexico, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, the Soviet Union, Spain, Switzerland and Yugoslavia.

October 31 of each year

October 31 of each year.  
December 31 of each year for Australia and New Zealand
