1.c. Rotational Indeterminate Employees

DFAIT rotational employees belong to nine groups. On December 31, 1999 this segment of the employee population numbered 1955 employees and represented 25 % of indeterminate departmental employees. One year later, the total number of rotational indeterminate employees was 1933, 24 % of indeterminate departmental employees.

More AS and EX employees work abroad, while the opposite is true for the other rotational groups. In 1999, Administrative support staff account for 18.8 % of all Canada-based staff stationed abroad. The 2000 figure was 17.1%.
