An Act to amend the Railway Act.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

R.S., c. 234.

1. Subsection (4) of section 353 of the *Railway Act* is repealed and the following substituted therefor:—

Bills of lading
to be in
French and
English
languages.

“(4) Railway companies shall print in both the English and French languages the bills of lading that are to be used along their lines.”
