1. In the case of each of the Ministers of the federal Cabinet, what is the total area of office space provided for the Minister and all those Assistants attached directly to his office?

2. In each case, what is the lease price per square foot or construction and furnishing cost on a per square foot basis?

Hon. Arthur Laing (Minister of Public Works): 1. The total office space occupied by each Federal Cabinet Minister combined with that occupied by each Parliamentary Secretary, Executive Assistant, Special Assistant and Research Assistant attached to each Minister's office is detailed on the attached list. The figures do not reflect accommodation provided in the Parliamentary buildings.

2. Owing to the variation in ages of the various Crown-owned buildings providing ministerial accommodation, it is not possible to give figures in answer to this question, 3. Program Administrative Officer, level 8 that will provide an accurate basis for information or comparison.
