3. How many complaints have been received from citizens against members of the RCMP for (a)
misconduct (b) improper police practice (c) excessive authoritarianism (d) unjust detention?
4. Have there been any charges laid under (a) RCMP regulations (b) Criminal Code (c) other federal or provincial statutes against members of the RCMP in each of the years 1960-68 inclusive, as a result of complaints?
5. How many members of the RCMP have been reprimanded during each of the years 1960-68 inclusive?

2. Two types of offences under the provisions of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police Act, RSC 1959, Chapter 54: Section 25-Major service offences. There are 16 such offences listed under this section. Section 26-Minor service offences. A violation of any of the Commissioner's Standing Orders or Regulations constitutes a Minor Service Offence
