### OBLIGATION OF A COMMITTEE-MAN.

I, *A. B.*, do solemnly swear that I will exercise the privileges, functions, and duties of a Committee-man faithfully, conscientiously, and impartially ; that I will use whatever influence I may possess for the benefit of my Lodge particular ; and generally for the interest of the Order, to the best of my skill, knowledge and cunning.

(The Committee may be all sworn together.)
