

Article 7.

PRESIDENT'S DUTIES

Sec. 1.—It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Local, to preserve order, and enforce the Constitution and By-Laws; to see that all officers perform their respective duties, and appoint all committees not otherwise provided for. He shall decide all questions of order, subject to an appeal by the Local. He shall have the right to vote, and when a tie on any question may occur, he shall give the deciding vote. He shall announce the result of all votes; he shall enforce all fines and penalties; he shall have power to call special meetings when requested by one-third or more members of the Local in writing; he shall sign all orders on the treasury for such money as shall by the Constitution and By-Laws, or by vote of the Local, be ordered paid; sign all cheques and drafts on bank, and perform such other duties as the Constitution and By-Laws of the Local may require.

FIRST AND SECOND VICE-PRESIDENTS' DUTIES

Sec. 2.—It shall be the duty of the first Vice-President, in the absence of the President, to preside and to perform all duties pertaining to the office of President, and to render such assistance as may be required of him. In case of a vacancy in the President's office, he shall preside until the Local selects a President to fill the vacancy. The duties of second Vice-President will be in accordance with those of first Vice-President.
