

4° Of a Judgment of Confirmation of Title
Sale under forced Licitation, a Sheriff's Sale or
an assignee's Sale : or,

5° When in favor of the Crown, of an
order in Council or a Certificate of the Laws'
Officers : or,

6° When Securing a life Rent, of the Cer-
tificate of death with an affidavit of Identification

On a demand being made for the Cancellati-
on of any registration & the production for that
purpose of any of the documents above enumerat-
ed, the Registrar has to decide whether the do-
cument exhibited is legally valid and sufficient
to authorize the cancellation; he has therefore
the right and in fact it is his duty to exact the
production of all documents necessary to establish
the quality and the capacity of the persons acting
in the acquittance or certificate exhibited, such
for instance as Procurations, Transfers, Subroga-
tions, Donations, Wills, Mariage, Contracts, Jud-
gment of Separation, etc. or of Sufficient Extract
from such documents.

When Satisfied as to the sufficiency of the
document produced, the Registrar proceeds to
effect the Cancellation asked for the formalities
which he has to observe are :

1° To enter the presentation of the docu-
ment produced, in the Entry-Book :

2° To transcribe all the documents pro-
duced in the Register, with the exception herein
after mentioned :

3° To deposit and keep on file in his
Office the documents produced ;

4° To cancel the registration by mentio-
ning in the margin of the registry of the hypothec
