By-Law No. 1.

A By-Law setting off and establishing Road Divisions and Poundkeepers' Divisions.

THEREAS it is expedient to establish Divisions for Road purposes and Poundkeepers within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of the Township of Matilda, Be it therefore enacted a By-Law of the Municipal Council aforesaid, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act of the Provincial Legislature, 12th Vic. chap. 81, entitled " An Act to provide, by a general law, for the erection of Municipal Corporations and the establishment of regulations of Police in and for the several Counties, Cities, Towns, Townships and Villages in Upper Canada," and it is hereby enacted that the several Divisions, as set off and described in the Township Clerk's books, shall be and are hereby constituted the Road Divisions for the Township; and that Pathmasters be appointed agreeable thereto.

And be it further enacted, That the several divisions as set off in the said Clerk's Books to which Pound-keepers have heretofore been appointed or elected shall be and remain to all intents and purposes, the same, and that Pound-keepers be appointed for the same, until altered by a By-Law of this Council.
