To speak of the Provinces of Alberta and Saskatchwan being "admitted into the union" on the first of July, 1905, is an improper and indefensible use of the expression. The territory included within the boundaries of these proposed provinces was "admitted into the union" on July 16, 1870, and 19 muediately upon the creation of these provinces the provisions of section 93 of the British North America Act of 1867 become as a matter of indefeasible right, a part of their constitution.
