All classes of matter may be registered to Postal Union countries on payment of registration fee of 5 cents. An acknowledgment of the reciept at destination of a registered letter may be obtained, if applied for at time of mailing, on payment of an additional fee of 5 cents by postage stamp.

Coin or jewellery must not be enclosed in letters, ordinary or registered. addressed to any country in the Postal Union, with the exception of the United States.

The postage on letters for Postal Union countries should be prepaid by the 5 cent or 10 cent stamp provided for that purpose.

## MAIL ROUTES.

Mails for England, including East Indian and European mails generally, are dispatched from Canada as follows:—

Once per week by Canadian steamer sailing every Sunday fron Quebec in summer, and every Saturday from Halifax in winter

Once a week by steamer, sailing from New York every Wednesday.

Once a week by Cunard (or other line of steamers) sailing from New York every Saturday.

Australia and China mails are sent as follows:-

Australia and New Zealand, with the exception of West Australia, via San Francisco, once a month, and via Vancouver, B. C. once a month.

West Australia, from England & Brindisi, weekly.

China and Japan, twice a month from Vancouver, British Columbia, and twice a month by way of San Francisco.

Bermuda, the West India Islands, the Isthmus of Panama and South America, via New York, twice a week on the principal sea routes and once a fortnight on less important lines, and twice monthly via Halifax and St.Johns, N. B.

Newfoundland packets sail four times a month from Halifax or Montreal.
