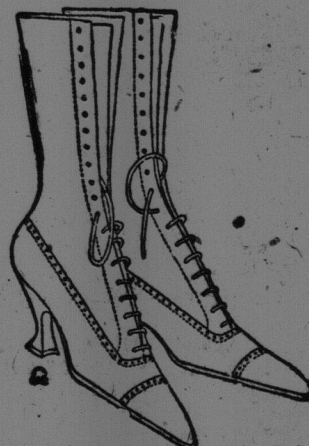

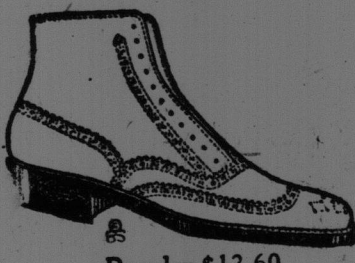

MEMORIAL TO MEMBERS WHO FELL IN WAR

London, Jan. 27.—(By Mail, Canadian Associated Press).—When Parliament assembles to begin the business of another session it is hoped that memorials to members of the two houses who fell in the great war will have been completed. Work upon them is now in progress, and the imposing monument in stone to perpetuate the names of legislators who made the supreme sacrifice is rapidly taking shape in St. Stephen's porch. This memorial, so placed that it will be seen by all who visit the Palace of Westminster, is to be supplemented, so far as members of the House of Commons are concerned, by another of unique form of commemoration in the debating chamber itself.

The monument which records the losses of both Houses is in the Gothic style, and is, therefore, in entire harmony with its surroundings. It has a central symbolical figure, flanked by two panels on which are carved the names of the fallen—members of the House of Lords on the left and those of the House of Commons on the right. At the foot of each appear the names of officials of the two houses, six in all, who joined the fighting forces and gave their lives for their country. The legislators whose sacrifice is here commemorated number thirty-nine—twenty peers and nineteen members of the House of Commons. Their names are placed in the order in which they died on sea or land, and an inscription at the base of the central figure will pay fitting tribute to their heroism.

The memorial, executed in Caen stone, is erected against the arched in St. Stephen's porch, beneath the great window, facing the steps leading down into Westminster Hall, and thus stands several feet distance from the entrance door. At present the House of Commons itself is without a memorial of any kind, not even a painted window, and so the fact that the names of its nineteen members are to be emblazoned in the Chamber marks a new departure. A series of enameled heraldic shields which will display the arms of the members are being prepared, to be placed at regular intervals along the front of the gallery facing the Chair. Above each shield will be a plate bearing in gold letters the name of the fallen member, and though the public, excepting occupants of the Ladies' Gallery, will be unable to see the shields, these will always be in full view of members of the House.

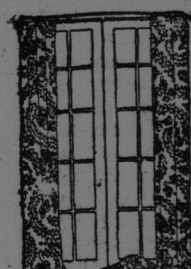

TRUSTEES TO CONFER WITH CITY COUNCIL

The school board at its meeting last night decided that it would wait upon the city council to confer regarding the increased salaries asked for by the teachers. It discussed adjustment of salaries and the opening of a commercial course and brought up the matter of the site for the school in West St. John which it was felt, the city council was blocking. The steps being taken to secure legislation for increased assessment were spoken of and a method for the award of the proffered French prize was approved.

An application for a position on the teaching staff was received from A. D. Brooks, of St. Stephen. Letters of thanks for leave of absence were received from Miss Clara Fullerton and Miss Margaret R. Graham.

Dr. Bridges reported for a special committee that it would be satisfactory to accept the French prize offered by W. F. Hatheway, which is to be a memorial to the late Mrs. Emma Pike, its award to be made on the results of the matriculation examination for which the scholars of the Union street and equal street high schools compete on equal terms, writing the papers in the same room. The report of this committee was received and its recommendations ordered carried out.

The report of the secretary showed 8,234 pupils enrolled and 88.7% of enrollment in daily attendance. That the experience and qualifications of special teachers had been overlooked in the fixing of maximum salaries, was set forth in a letter from the four special teachers.
