Resumption of immigration on a large scale and efforts to deport alien anarchists made the last fiscal year the busiest of any since the inauguration of the immigration service, the report says, "with indications that pre-war immigration figures would be outdistanced unless affected by laws of this or other countries."

"Chinese immigration," the report continues, "show an increase over the preceding year, the number of admissions having risen from 3,840 coming for permanent residence in 1919 to 4,690 in 1920, these figures not including allens of the Chinese race granted transient privelege. Of the citizen class of Chinese persons there were admitted in all, 1881, of whom 897 were of native born parents and 141 were foreign born wives of American citizens of the Chinese race.

Mr. Caminetti says that while these events were in progress the Communist and Communist Labor Party became active and in the neighborhood of 5,000 warrants for the arrests were issued. Approximately 8,000 of these warrants were served and 556 of those arrested were ordered deported.

Detailing immigration for the year, Mr. Caminetti presents statistics to show that the proportion of females among immigrant aliens as a whole was 42.4 per cent. of the total in 1920 as compared with 38.5 per cent in the four years before the war. He says this increase is especially noted in the case of European peoples among whom the proportion of females was consistently low prior to the world war. The Commissioner General adds, however, that "this fact has little or no significance under the circumstances unless possibly the very large increases among the Greeks and Italians give a hint that the immigration of these peoples in the future may be somewhat more permanent than in the past.'
