DRAFTING RUSSIANS.

(Bangor Commercial.)
A report says that the Germans have begun to attempt to draft Russians into the German army and the development of the effort will be watched with interest. Evidently the Russians must fight on one side or the other and their preference will be that of the Allies where they reach them. We doubt if the Germans would attempt to place drafted Russians on the fighting front for they would fear desertions. Rather they will use them in Germany, as guards in prison camps and supply depots and well behind the lines. If the report is true Berlin has furnished another incentive for the Russians to make common cause with the Allies and for every soldier Germany thereby obtains it is safe to say that more than one will join the Allies or the revolutionists to avoid service under the German flag.
